Brazos County Detention Center Volunteer Application

Thank you for your interest in volunteering with individuals involved in the criminal justice system. As you consider volunteering your time with our agency, please note that anyone applying to participate as a volunteer at any of the Brazos County Sheriff's Office (BCSO) facilities will be subject to a criminal history background check prior. Prior to approval a volunteer orientation session must be completed.

Volunteer Criteria:

- Anyone arrested, convicted, or has had periods of incarcerations for any offense must wait 18 months after last recorded incident.
- ➤ Anyone that has been on parole or probation must wait 18 months after completing supervision.
- Anyone with three or more arrests, convictions, or incarcerations in the last ten years can be rejected.
- Anyone convicted of offenses against a correctional facility and or officers of a correctional facility can be rejected and denied access to volunteering opportunities.
- Anyone convicted of possession of a controlled substance in a correctional facility can be rejected and denied access to volunteering opportunities.

Being that safety is always a priority for all parties involved, if <u>any</u> approved volunteer who is found to violate any BCSO facility and or volunteer rules, he or she will be subject to temporary or permanent dismissal. To ensure that the application is reviewed in a timely manner, please ensure that it is completed accurately and all required documents are attached.
